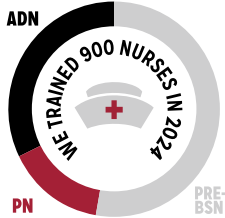

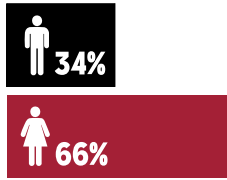

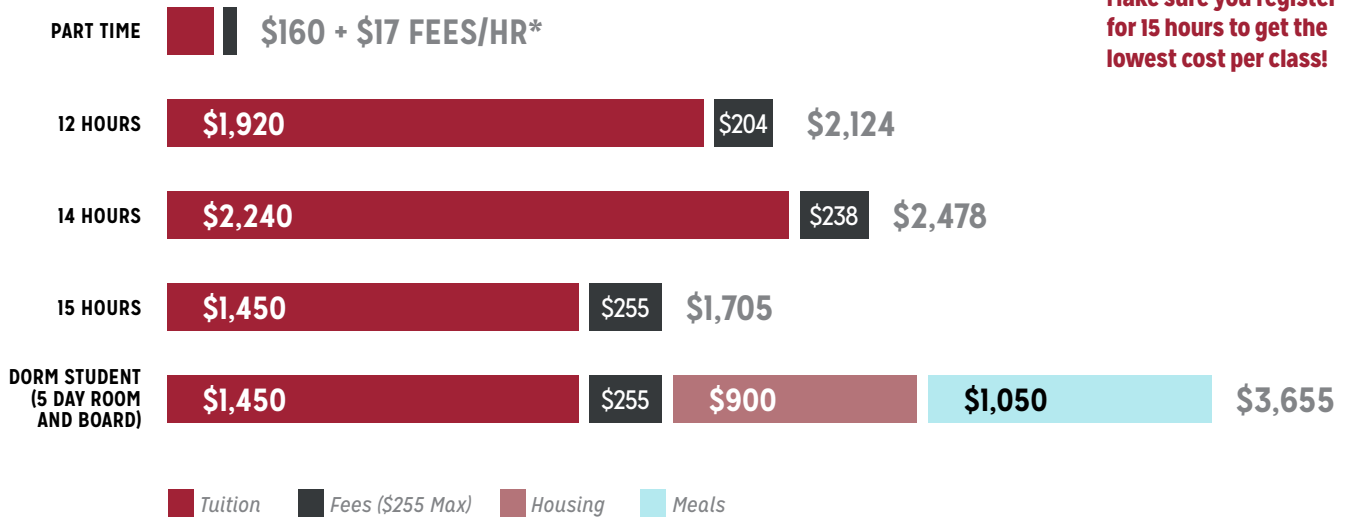

### OUR TUITION HASN'T INCREASED

THIS YEAR, SIX OF MISSISSIPPI'S 4-YEAR UNIVERSITIES HAVE INCREASED THEIR TUITION BY AN AVERAGE OF 3.8%. HOLMES HAS NOT RAISED TUITION, AND CONTINUES TO BE ONE OF THE MOST AFFORDABLE COLLEGES IN THE STATE.

## **HOLMES ACT SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **BOARD OF TRUSTEES ACT SCHOLARSHIP**

This Scholarship is awarded to students with enhanced ACT composite scores of 28 or higher. Covers tuition, room, and board costs.\*

### **PRESIDENT'S ACT SCHOLARSHIP**

The President's Scholarship is awarded to students with an enhanced ACT composite score of 24 to 27. Covers one-half of tuition, room, and board costs\*

### **DEAN'S ACT SCHOLARSHIP**

The Dean's Scholarship is awarded to students with an enhanced ACT composite score of 20 to 23. Covers cost of tuition.\*

*\*ACT scholarship recipients must meet in-state requirements. Must be full time and maintain a minimum GPA. Not available for summer classes. ACT Scholarships are not needs based.*

## **HCC INTEREST-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS**

Available through the HCC Foundation for students in specific majors and programs of study. (May 1 deadline.) Amount awarded varies.

### **PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIPS**

Available for students who excel within various departments. This includes programs such as choral music, band, Dazzlers and much more. Amount awarded varies.

### **HOLMES PLUS SCHOLARSHIP**

Offered on the Goodman Campus. Students must be accepted into the Holmes Plus Program, and score 24 or higher on the ACT with a math sub-score of 23. Covers the majority of educational expenses, such as tuition and room and board after all other scholarships and aid have been applied.

### **ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS**

Available for students who excel in athletics. This includes programs such as cheer, baseball, basketball, football, soccer, tennis and softball. Amount awarded varies.

## **HCC DISTRICT AREA SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **SUMNER'S GRANT**

For residents of Attala, Choctaw, Carroll, Montgomery, and Webster counties who desire and can benefit from a higher education. (FAFSA not required). Award amount is based on enrollment status and fund availability. Holmes is the only community college eligible for the Sumner's Grant.

### **MARIE MAXEY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS – GRENADA**

Three scholarships will be awarded to Grenada High School or Kirk Academy graduating seniors. During the decision process, additional weight will be given to a graduating senior who plans to attend Holmes Community College.

### **CALHOUN COUNTY TUITION ASSISTANCE GRANT**

Grant for residents of Calhoun County. Covers tuition after all federal and state grants and other financial aid and scholarships are applied. Tuition is funded for four consecutive semesters (excluding summer). Holmes is one of only three schools eligible for this grant.

### **STEEL DRUM BAND**

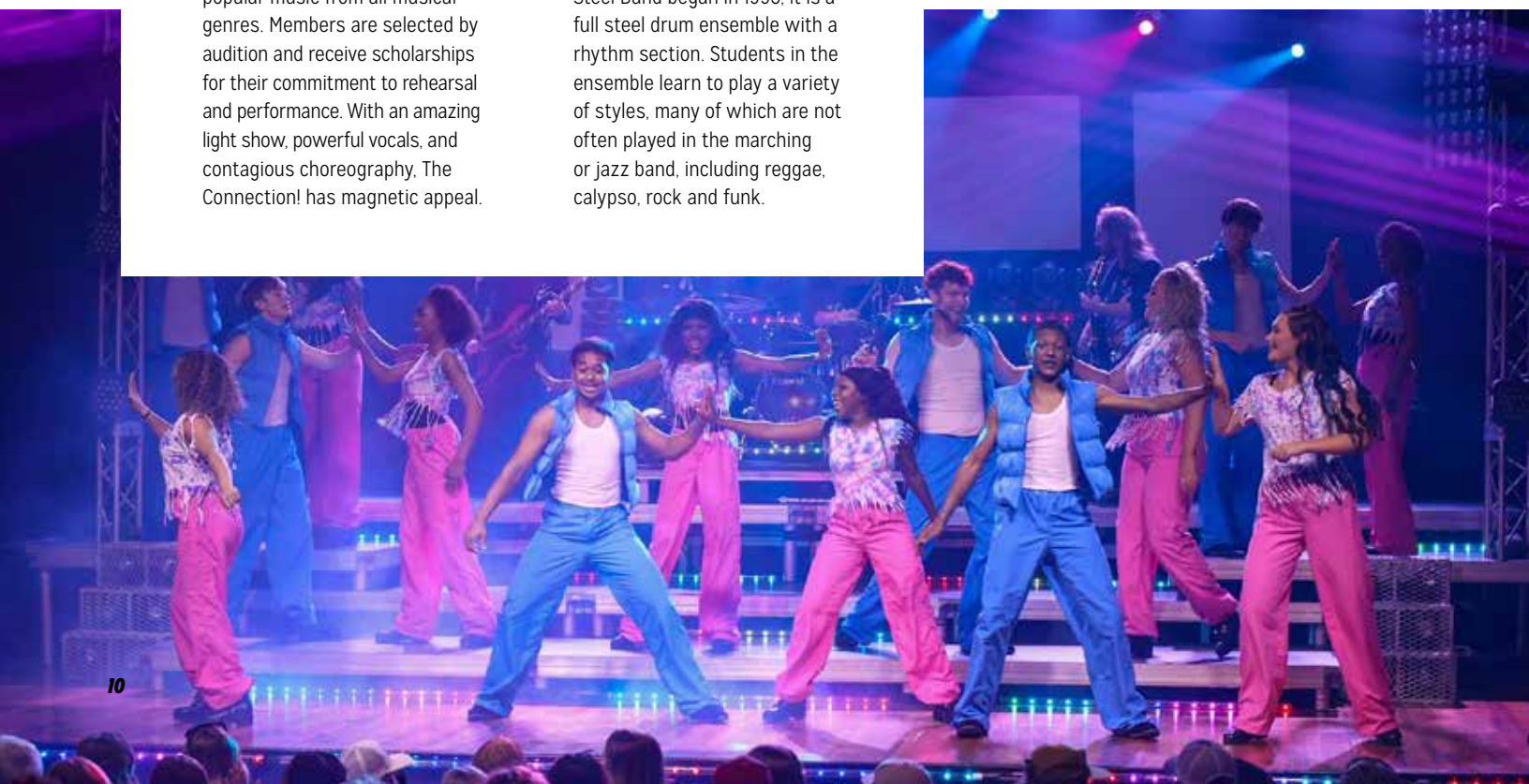

### SCHOLAR ATHLETES

For the 2024-2025 season, seventy-six bulldogs were named as scholar athletes, with GPAs of 3.4 or higher.
